HOW TO PRAY FOR THE LOST

Declare the following prayer points:

1. I/we declare as a believer(s) in Christ (II Corinthians 6:15) that the Lord sanctifies for salvation the following people by name (fill out the list of names below). (I Peter 1:2, II Thessalonians 2:13-13)

2. I/we declare an encourager(s) (I Thessalonians 5:11) that the Lord gives them faith to believe the gospel (Romans 12:3)

3. I/we declare as an intercessor(s) (Luke 6:28, James 5:16) that the Lord removes all curses and blesses them (Luke 10:1-5, Romans 2:4)

4. I/we declare as a judge(s) in the Kingdom of Heaven (I Corinthians 5:12) that the Lord convicts them of sin, righteousness and judgement through Holy Spirit (John 16:8-11)

5. I/we declare as a witness(es) of the truth of God's revelation (Acts 1:8) that the Lord illuminates their minds to the truth (II Corinthians 4:6, Acts 24:25)

6. I/we declare as an evangelist(s) (Mark 16:15) that the Lord makes divine appointments for them with gospel workers and witnesses who are equipped with power, boldness, wisdom, zeal, compassion, and divine insight to tell them the unhindered, complete and uncompromised truth of the gospel and God's other revelations (Matthew 9:37, 38, Luke 19:10, Acts 1:4-5, Acts 4:31, Proverbs 11:30, Colossians 4:12-13, Judge 22, 23, Jeremah 33:3)

I/we declare as a king(s) and priest(s) (queen(s) and priestess(esses)) in the Kingdom of Heaven (Revelation1:6), that by my divinely granted authority that the defenses of the devil against the gospel are utterly destroyed by the angels of the Lord (II Corinthians 10:4-5) forte glory and dominion of the Lord is forever and ever!

8. I/we declare as a believer(s) in Christ that God's will prevails and the fruit of His Word is effective and multiplies.

9. I declare as a disciple of Christ (Luke 14:26-33) that the devil cannot steal the Word that has been planted in their hearts (Acts 2:37, John 8:32, Mark 4:15)

10. I/we declare as a Minister(s) of Reconciliation (II Corinthians 5:18) that the Lord receives all the glory that is due to Him and Christ will have all that He paid for in His Passion.
