And at the end of ten days their faces looked better and fatter of flesh than all the boys who were eating the king's food. So Melzar took away their food and the wine that they were to drink, and he gave them vegetables. As for these four boys, God gave them knowledge and skill in all writing and wisdom. And Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams. And at the end of the days that the king had said to bring them in, the chief of the eunuchs brought them in before Nebuchadnezzar. And the king talked with them. And among them all was found none like Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah. So they stood before the king. And in any matter of wisdom and understanding that the king asked from them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and the conjurers who were in all his kingdom.
